Imagine yourself visiting an unfamiliar place, and you are having some trouble finding your way. You might need to ask for some help! The first and second graders were happy to take part in our “I am lost, and I need directions” skit.



“Excuse me, Ma’am. Can you please help me?”

“Sure. What can I do for you?”

“I need to go to the computer lab, but I don’t know how to get there.”



“Take the stairs to the third floor. The computer lab is at the end of the hallway to your right.”

Figuring out how to give directions for turning right or left was a challenge, but students did very well after they had some practice.
