The Grade 5 and 6 students are learning to fill out arrival cards, received from flight attendants during flight and required for entering a country.



At the immigration counter, students played the role of immigration officers and of travelers. They had to provide flight numbers, passports and travel documents.

Students pretended to be the officers and asked typical questions like; What is the nature of your visit? How long are you staying? Where will you be staying?
