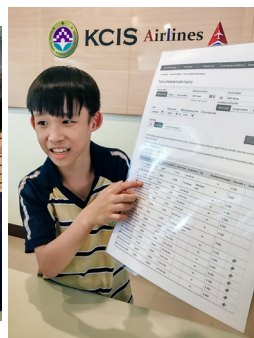


Purchasing a Train Ticket

購買火車票



Purchasing a train ticket is easy. The third and fourth graders arrived at the ticket counter and stated their departure date and time. The ticket clerk checked for available seats and sold the tickets to the travellers.
